

# Expanded Test Window for NAPLAN Online

The test window for NAPLAN Online will be nine days. This expanded test window allows schools more flexibility in scheduling and accommodates schools which have fewer devices than students. Schools may choose to complete testing sooner. At the school's discretion, multiple sessions may be held each day.

The test window for paper-based NAPLAN will remain at three days.

NAPLAN Online tests will need to be taken in a specific order. This will increase security of the writing prompt

and is required for some test linkages. For instance, students must complete the reading test before accessing the conventions of language test, so that the results of the reading test can be used to determine the level of difficulty of the conventions of language test items (tailored test design).

The table below shows the sequence and timing of NAPLAN Online tests.

All students in a school must complete one domain before moving onto the next (other than catch-ups).
