# Checking if you have the correct version of the locked down browser installed

- All students taking part in NAPLAN online tests must install a locked down browser application suitable for their device.
- The icons of the locked down browser varies depending on device type.
- Check your device to make sure the icon aligns to the device type as shown below:

# Windows – updated locked down browsers (LDB) for 2025

- The updated browser is available for schools and jurisdictions to download on the Assessform website.
- It must be installed on all Windows devices being used for NAPLAN 2025.
- It can also be used for low-bandwidth schools.
- Schools can confirm that they have installed the correct version of the LDB on their devices by checking for a purple icon with the text 'NAP 2025':



# Mac and iPad devices – current locked down browsers (LDB) for 2025

- The current browser is available for schools and jurisdictions to download on the Assessform website.
- It must be installed on all Mac and iPad devices being used for NAPLAN 2025.
- It can also be used for low-bandwidth schools (recommended for Windows and Mac only).
- ACARA does not recommend the use of iPad devices in low-bandwidth schools.
- Schools can confirm that they have installed the correct version of the LDB on their devices by checking for a green icon with the text 'NAP 2025':



### Chromebook – no changes to locked down browser (LDB) for 2025


- Chromebook devices continue to use the NAP locked down browser used for NAPLAN 2024.
- Schools that already have this browser installed on Chromebooks do not need to reinstall it.
- Schools with Chromebooks that don't yet have the locked down browser installed can download the LDB from the Assessform website.
- Schools using Chromebooks can confirm they have installed the correct version of the LDB on their devices by checking its icon is white with blue writing:



**Android devices** are not supported for use in NAPLAN.

# Windows






- Select the Windows Start button and search for NAP Locked down browser.
- Select NAP Locked down browser to launch it.

# Mac



 Using the operating system Finder app, search for the NAP Locked down browser in the Applications folder.

# Chromebooks NAP



The Chromebook NAP locked down browser is designed to automatically start on the student device. It must be pre-installed in Kiosk Mode by your school IT or technical support officer. BYOD Chromebooks are not supported for NAPLAN.

- 1. On the login screen, select **Apps** from the bottom left of the screen.
- 2. Select the NAP Locked down browser 0.16.0.1
- 3. Once opened, press the Esc key to test if the correct browser is installed.
- 4. If the application closes, the browser is not correctly installed. For assistance, ask your school IT or nominated technical support officer to install the browser.

#### Touchscreens are not supported on Windows and Chromebook devices

- Windows and Chromebook touchscreen functionality is not supported as outlined in their Locked Down Browser User Guides on <a href="https://www.assessform.edu.au">www.assessform.edu.au</a>
- Answers selected on a Windows or Chromebook touchscreen may not be recorded and so may show as unanswered
  on the summary screen or when reviewed by students.
- An external keyboard and mouse (or touchpad) must be used instead of touchscreens.

#### Windows CoPilot+ devices

Windows CoPilot+ devices are supported for NAPLAN 2025.
