Third party materials

Information for use

NAPLAN exemplar items are available through the Student and School Summary Report (SSSR). Exemplars are indicative of the curriculum content and skill assessed and the relative difficulty of the original items they exemplify. Some exemplars contain Third Party Materials that are licensed for educational use in connection with NAPLAN. Restrictions on the use of Third Party Materials are outlined in Table 1 below. Items that contain Third Party Materials are listed by the Online National Assessment Platform item ID in Table 2.

If you wish to copy or communicate the Exemplar Items, you should ensure that you do so in accordance with:

- the Statutory Licence created by section 113P of the Copyright Act 1968 (Statutory Licence);
- the restrictions of use below.

Restrictions on the use of NAPLAN Exemplar Items

1. Exemplar Items are not to be publicly released at any time.
2. Exemplar Items can be uploaded to a website, intranet site or equivalent media that is password-protected and used only for educational purposes. Paragraphs 3 to 7 below set out further restrictions that apply Third Party Materials contained in the Exemplar Items.

Third party restrictions

3. Third Party Materials can only be used in post-test materials, namely student and teacher support and teaching materials (including, without limitation, school classroom testing) in connection with the NAP.
4. Any images, vectors and clips can only be edited, modified and adapted by adding annotations such as speech balloons besides or over such materials to provide commentary to teachers or students.
5. Where such teacher support materials are made available in digital form, any downloads can only be from a password-protected platform.
6. You cannot sub-license rights in Third Party Materials.
7. No or very limited moral rights consent has been obtained from the creator of the Third Party Materials, and accordingly:
 - a. You must attribute the creator of the materials using exactly the same words as set out in Table 2 below;
 - b. You must be careful that any editing, adapting or modifying of the copyright material does not prejudice the creator's honour or reputation ("derogatory treatment"); and
 - c. If you change the copyright material, you must note what has been changed (to avoid false attribution).
